- The original Bachelor diploma legalized by the Polish Embassy or apostilled, translated into Polish or English prepared or certified by sworn translator.

- Transcript of grades that entitles to attend second-cycle programmes along with an official grading scheme, translated into Polish or English prepared or certified by sworn translator.
- English certificate.
- A valid visa, temporary stay permit card or another document legally validating your stay in Poland.
- Health insurance policy and accident insurance, covering the whole period of studies in Poland, or European Health Insurance Card or proof of NFZ insurance (Polish National Health Fund).
- Other documents submitted into online enrollment system during the admission process.

The regular courses will start on 26.02.2022. The Master's program lasts 3 semesters.

Poznan University of Technology informs that in cases of force majeure, it may be necessary to complete the first semester of study in the online form. You will be kept informed about the form of education. Force majeure is understood as external events, independent of the Parties and unpredictable, such as in particular war, fire, epidemic, flood, communication blockades, or social disasters.
